

AP Spanish Summer Assignment

Hola, future AP Spanish student!

Felicidades for embarking on one more phase of your Spanish studies. In order to maintain your Spanish skills throughout the summer, you will be reading a short novel & writing about it, as well as keeping a log of Spanish listening/watching experiences throughout the summer. The purpose of these assignments is not to overwhelm you the LAST week of summer but rather to keep your Spanish fresh throughout the ENTIRE summer, **little by little**. This way, when we come back to school in August, you should be able to pick up right where you left off and not have too much of a gap in your Spanish skills.

So, let's get to the assignments.

- As stated above, you will be **reading a short novel**. Before reading the novel, read the back cover summary. After reading the novel, you will write a 1-page book report in Spanish. There should be no header...just your name and your report. Please use Calibri, size 12, 1.5 spacing with 1-inch margins. *(basic book report: title, author, genre, short summary of setting and theme, character descriptions/analyses, purpose of book, what's the main plot, summarize important points, anything you learned, would you recommend)* When completed you will turn into Sra. Fluke via Google Classroom.
- You will also be completing **10 hours of Spanish listening experiences per month** and filling out the **listening log** as you do it. I know, I know, this sounds cray, BUT...try Netflix and you will be done before you know it, not to mention be hooked on a new show! However, this can be any combination of things: it could be speaking with Spanish speakers, listening to/watching Spanish music videos, Spanish YouTube videos, Spanish movies or anything else you may come across.
